

ZONING CASE ONGOING IN CIRCUIT COURT

The plaintiffs' appeal to the Clay County circuit Court to rescind the action of the Village Board of Adjustment for rezoning the Lloyd property was filed with the Circuit Court and the Village has delivered all of the paper work required by the Court. VILLAGE ELECTION

The Village election for two trustees will be held on Tuesday, April 4 2006 at the Knights of Columbus building at 1500 N. E. Englewood Road from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

At this election two residents will be elected to the Board of Trustees to serve for a period of two (2) years each. The present trustees whose terms expire in April 2006 are John C. Howell and Mary Lou Butterworth.

Trustees serve the Village without compensation because of their concern for the welfare of the Village. The Board meets on the second Monday of each month at the Oakview City Hall, 6404 N. Locust at 7:00 p.m. for approximately one to two hours. Each trustee accepts a specific assignment for such responsibilities as road maintenance ditch clearing contact with electric and gas companies when attention is needed by these utilities.
